

# TEN-YEAR LIMITED WARRANTY

(Effective January 1, 2026)

IMECAR LLC, a Florida, USA corporation ("IMECAR"), provides this Ten-Year Limited Warranty to the original purchaser ("Purchaser") of an IMECAR-branded battery (the "Battery") purchased from IMECAR or an IMECAR-authorized distributor or dealer. Subject to the terms below, IMECAR warrants that the Battery will be free from defects in materials and workmanship under normal use and service for ten (10) years from the retail purchase date shown on Purchaser's sales receipt (the "Warranty Period"). This warranty is a limited warranty and is the sole and exclusive warranty provided by IMECAR for the Battery.

## 1. NON-TRANSFERABLE; WHO IS COVERED

This Limited Warranty applies only to the original Purchaser of the Battery and may not be assigned or transferred. For assistance with a warranty claim, contact the original place of purchase or follow the claim process described below.

## 2. EXCLUSIONS (WHAT IS NOT COVERED)

This Limited Warranty does not apply to, and does not cover, any Battery that has been subjected to any of the following:

- Damage resulting from the Battery being unsecured or inadequately secured.
- Incorrect installation, operation, maintenance, charging practices, or service.
- Loose terminal connections or poor contact at Battery terminals.
- Batteries connected in series.
- More than three (3) Batteries connected in parallel.
- Reverse-polarity wiring or connections.
- Storage or environmental conditions outside the Battery Owner's Manual, including exposure to ambient temperatures above 140°F or below -40°F, fire, submersion in water, pressure washing, or storage in a fully discharged condition.
- Any short circuit caused by accidental, intentional, or inadvertent connection between the positive and negative terminals.
- Impact, accident, collision, or dropping the Battery.
- Undercharging or overcharging as defined in the applicable Battery Owner's Manual.
- Use with third-party products or components that fail or cause the Battery to fail.
- High resistance caused by corroded terminals, poor crimps, or insufficient cable size.
- Failure caused by a faulty electrical system in the vehicle/equipment/application.
- Any Battery that has been opened, modified, altered, or tampered with in any manner.
- Use in applications other than those for which the Battery was designed, including repeated engine starting or drawing more continuous current than the Battery is rated to deliver.
- A Battery that has not been charged for more than one (1) year (periodic charging is required to maintain cell health).





- Commercial use in which the Battery is repeatedly cycled to more than 80% depth of discharge within 24-hour periods.

### 3. REGISTRATION REQUIRED FOR FULL-TERM COVERAGE

To receive coverage for the full Warranty Period, Purchaser must register the Battery at [us.imecar.com/warranty](https://us.imecar.com/warranty). If a Battery is not registered within thirty (30) days of the purchase date, then, notwithstanding anything else in this Limited Warranty, coverage will be limited to one (1) year from the purchase date shown on valid proof of purchase.

### 4. REMEDIES AND COVERAGE SCHEDULE

If a registered Battery is determined by IMECAR to have a defect in materials or workmanship during the Warranty Period, Purchaser's remedy will be as follows:

1. Years 0-5 from the purchase date: IMECAR will, at its option, repair the Battery or replace it with a new or Certified Refurbished Battery of the same type, at no charge (the "Repair or Replace Term").
2. After 5 years and through the end of year 8 from the purchase date: Purchaser may obtain a replacement Battery at a price equal to fifty percent (50%) of IMECAR's then-current manufacturer's suggested retail price (MSRP) for that Battery type.
3. After 8 years and through the end of year 10 from the purchase date: Purchaser may obtain a replacement Battery at a price equal to seventy-five percent (75%) of IMECAR's then-current MSRP for that Battery type.

IMECAR may choose to provide a Certified Refurbished Battery as a replacement to reduce turnaround time. When a Battery is replaced, the original purchase date provided at registration will carry over to the replacement Battery, and the remaining Warranty Period will continue to be measured from that original purchase date (unless this warranty has been voided).

### 5. SHIPPING, HANDLING, AND RETURN PROCEDURES

During the Repair or Replace Term, IMECAR will provide suitable packaging and will arrange shipment of the Battery to IMECAR for inspection and service. Purchaser must prepay IMECAR \$250 as a shipping and handling fee for this return process.

IMECAR will pay the cost to ship the serviced or replacement Battery back to a Purchaser address within the United States of America. For Purchasers outside the United States, Purchaser is responsible for any shipping costs above the \$250 prepaid amount.

### 6. DISCLAIMER OF OTHER WARRANTIES

This Limited Warranty is provided in lieu of all other express warranties, and IMECAR hereby disclaims and excludes all other express warranties. To the maximum extent permitted by law, any implied warranties, including without limitation any implied warranty of merchantability or fitness for a particular purpose, are limited in duration to the Warranty Period.

### 7. LIMITATION OF LIABILITY





IMECAR's liability for any claim arising out of or relating to the Battery or this Limited Warranty shall be limited to the remedies set forth above. In no event will IMECAR be liable for any indirect, incidental, special, exemplary, or consequential damages, including without limitation lost profits, loss of use, towing, service calls, removal or installation costs, shipping expenses, property damage, personal injury, lost time, inconvenience, or lost wages, even if advised of the possibility of such damages.

## 8. LEGAL RIGHTS; GOVERNING LAW

Some states and/or countries do not allow limitations on how long an implied warranty lasts or the exclusion or limitation of incidental or consequential damages. As a result, the limitations or exclusions above may not apply to Purchaser. This Limited Warranty gives Purchaser specific legal rights, and Purchaser may also have other rights that vary by state or country.

This Limited Warranty is governed by and construed in accordance with the laws of the State of Florida, USA, without regard to conflicts of law principles. This Limited Warranty is the complete and exclusive agreement between IMECAR and Purchaser regarding the Battery. No employee, dealer, or representative is authorized to modify this Limited Warranty or make any additional warranty on behalf of IMECAR.

## 9. OUT-OF-WARRANTY SERVICE

If a Battery is outside the Warranty Period, or if the issue is excluded from coverage, IMECAR may, in its sole discretion, offer to repair the Battery for a fee. IMECAR will provide an estimate for repair and return shipping before performing any out-of-warranty service.

## 10. HOW TO SUBMIT A WARRANTY CLAIM

To initiate a warranty claim, contact the original place of purchase or submit a claim request at [us.imecar.com/claim](https://us.imecar.com/claim). IMECAR may require the Battery to be returned for inspection.

A Return Merchandise Authorization (RMA) must be obtained from IMECAR before any Battery is shipped to IMECAR. Any shipment received without a valid RMA will be refused, and all shipping charges will be the sole responsibility of Purchaser. The RMA number must be clearly marked on the outside of the package. After receiving an RMA, Purchaser must ship the Battery to the IMECAR warehouse location specified in the RMA instructions.
